Want to be free Forever

?

Jesus Christ came to set the prisoners free!!

I The Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles: to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

I am The Lord: that is My Name: and My glory will I not give to another, neither My praise to graven images. Isaiah 42 v 6-8

Come now, let us reason together, saith The Lord: though your sins be as scarlet; they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. Isaiah 1 v 18.

Did you know my friend, that you could be free, even though you are in prison serving a prison sentence ??

Equally, did you know that you could be a prisoner even though you are *not* in prison for any crime ??

These two sentences seem to be a bit of a contradiction, don't they. Well, let me explain. In the sight of God we are all condemned sinners, worthy of punishment and eternal damnation, whether in prison serving a sentence, or free, never having committed any offence worthy of prison.

We are all prisoners of our sin!!

There is none righteous, no, not one. Romans 3 v 9
There is none that doeth good, no, not one. Romans 3 v 12
For all have sinned, and come short of the Glory of God. Romans 3 v 23.

You see, in God's eyes we're all equally guilty of breaking His laws - All are condemned already.

John 3:18:- He that believeth on Him is not condemned; but he that believeth not is condemned already, because He hath not believed in the Name of the Only Begotten Son of God. John 3 v 18

There is only one way to receive a pardon for your sins or crimes against God and that is to receive Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord of your life.

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto The Father, but by ME. John 14 v 6

For whosoever shall call upon The Name of The Lord shall be saved. Romans 10 v13

Notice that He says, *whosoever* calls shall be saved. The Lord makes no preconditions, No 'Ifs' or 'But's,' only come as you are, regardless of age, class, colour, background or crime.

My friend, no matter what you have done, there is hope and forgiveness and a fresh start in Jesus Christ.

Just ask Him sincerely from your heart, to forgive your sin, to help you make a new start from this moment, genuinely repenting of your past life.

I urge you to make this *your* prayer right now, not later on, not tomorrow because tomorrow might never come.

2 Corinthians 6:2: For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, NOW is the accepted time; behold, NOW is the day of salvation.

If you have asked the Lord earnestly and sincerely to forgive your sins and to take control of your life, you will know what it is to be really free, whether you are locked up in a prison cell or not. You have become a child of God, with all the privileges that entails. For you, there is now no fear of death or judgement beyond, there is peace of mind and contentment, and of course, eternal life in heaven is now a reality.

2 Corinthians 5:17:- Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creation: old things are passed away behold, all things are become new.

However, believe me, if you continue to REJECT The Lord and remain unsaved, then the sentence has already been passed.

John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

If you are *not* 'born again' of The Spirit of God, your eternity will be spent in HELL!!

Then shall He say also unto them on the left hand, depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels. Matthew 25:41

Hell is an eternal prison, created by God, for the devil, his angels and the unsaved . There will be no parole or release date, no days off or holidays in that terrible place of torment. As The Bible says, a place of weeping and wailing and gnashing of teeth.

...into the fire that never shall be quenched. Mark 9 v 45

Do not be part of it!! Turn to Jesus..... Whether Prisoner, Prison officer, Governor or Lawyer – Discover what it is to be truly free!!

Almost two thousand years ago, Jesus Christ was nailed to a wooden cross by Roman soldiers. In great pain and agony He took our punishment and shame. **He** paid the price for our sins with His own innocent blood. He died for our freedom and pardon. He died that we might go free.

He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed. Isaiah 53 v 5.

Reach out to Jesus, right now and accept that eternal pardon and release, only then will you find real freedom.

Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved!! Amen.
