O GIVE THANKS UNTO THE LORD FOR HE IS GOOD, HIS MERCY ENDURETH FOR EVER. PSALM 136 v 1.

God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgement, because as He is, so are we in this world.

1 John 4 v 16-17.

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear; because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

1 John 4 v 18.

We love HIM, because HE first loved us. If any man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar; for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? 1 John 4 v 19-20

And this Commandment have we from HIM, that he who loveth God loves his brother also. 1 John 4 v 21.
